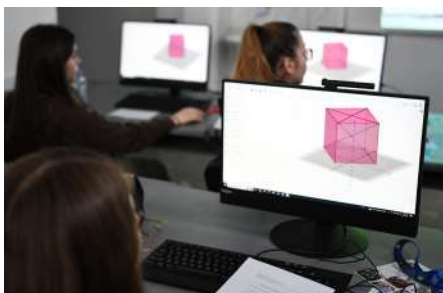

Duration of student mobility:

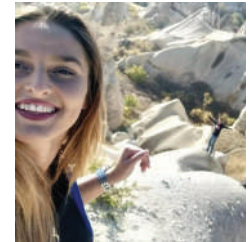
- For studies: 3-12 months (1 or 2 semesters).

Criteria for academic and administrative staff mobility:

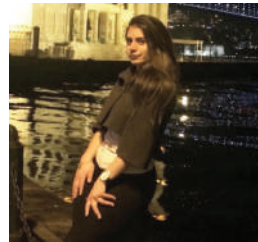
- To speak English or the language of host University.

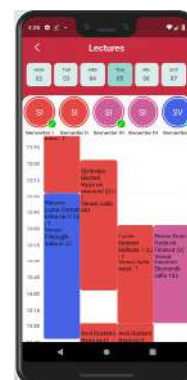

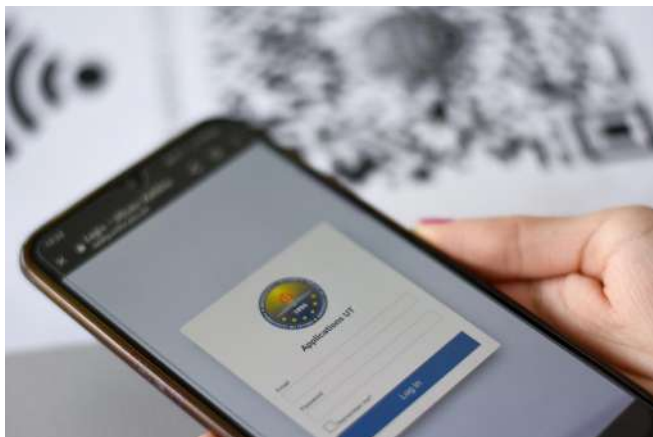

HOW TO APPLY?

- First, make the payment for the application at the bank, post office or online at: <https://epay.unite.edu.mk>.
- Take a photo or scan of the payment slip and any documents required for the application:
 - ▶ **Certificate of Citizenship;**
 - ▶ **Birth Certificate;**
 - ▶ **Certificates for completion of secondary education;**
 - ▶ **Diploma for completion of secondary education;**
 - ▶ **Confirmation which proves that the candidate is employed (for those wishing to study as part-time students);**

- ▶ *Please enter your email address and personal information accurately;*
 - ▶ *Attach the photographed (screened) documents in the relevant sections;*
 - ▶ *Enter the grades from the secondary education certificate into the appropriate rubrics as they appear on the certificate;*
 - ▶ *After filling in all the data, submit the form.*
- After submitting the form along with the email used for application, you will receive confirmation of your application and the password for your application profile. You can then proceed to register upon acceptance.
 - **Submit the documents to the faculty where you applied online, within the application dates;**
 - The candidate is responsible for the online application and it is a prerequisite for submitting the documents to the administration.
 - In your application profile, monitor the stages for document submission to the administration, review of documentation by the commission, ranking, and both preliminary and final results.

Admission results will be announced on your profile and on the website of the University of Tetova: **www.unite.edu.mk**.

HOW THE REGISTRATION IS DONE?

The candidate accepted in the final results, first makes the payments for the semester and other obligations, then registers the semester from the applicant's profile through the email with which they applied and the password received in the email.

Submit your documents to the student services of the faculty:

- Application for registration;
- Three photos;
- Payment of the first semester at the amount provided for the accepted quota;
- Other payments for: (Please find the amounts you need to pay in the announced call for admission);
- Index;
- Informative and cultural activities of the University students;
- Registration is completed only if the above documentation is submitted to the student service.

APPLICATION AND REGISTRATION GUIDE

ATTENTION! What happens if you have been accepted, but you have not registered by the deadline?

- It is considered that you have renounced from your studies even though you have been accepted;
- In the next call for admission your position will be declared free;
- You have the right to apply again according to the same procedures;
- Apply only at those study programs which are vacant;
- The status of quota that you had in the previous application term won't be preserved.

HOW IS THE CANDIDATE'S RANKING DONE?

- Ranking of the candidates on the list is based on points earned;
- A candidate who has applied for the regular status of studies, but has higher points will enter the state quota for as much vacancies as provided in the call for Admission;
- The remaining candidates enter the studies with a self-financing for as much vacancies as foreseen in the call for admission for this quote;
- After all vacancies are filled out, other candidates remain inadmissible;
- Candidates that apply for the studies with correspondence do not compete in these two quotes, but they compete with candidates who apply to study with a part-time status. For this category of candidates, the rules stated above apply;
- Once the number of candidates with correspondence is filled out, others remain inadmissible, although there may be vacancies in state or co-financing quota.

CANDIDATES WHO ARE NOT CITIZENS OF THE REPUBLIC OF NORTH MACEDONIA?

- Foreign nationals during the ranking do not compete with the nationals of the Republic of North Macedonia;
- The number of admission places for these candidates is limited to 20% at the faculty level;
- Once this number at the faculty level is completed, other candidates are not accepted;
- After accepted, these candidates should regulate their nostrifications and their permit of stay in Republic of North Macedonia.

WHEN A COMPLAINT SHOULD BE FILED?

- Within 8h after the announcement of preliminary results (online or in written);
- If the name is not on the list (the name must necessarily be published, regardless of the outcome achieved);
- If the student's success score is calculated incorrectly;
- If the Ranking Commission has wrongly ranked the student in any other study program;
- If the reason for the rejection is not clear, etc.
